The Parents of Linda Ray Kasper Leonardi were married September 19, 1942, in Canton, MO. Linda Ray was about 15 months old when her Father, Staff



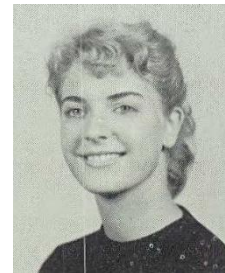
Sargent Raymond Arthur Kasper, World War II Veteran of the United States Army, was killed in action on December 16, 1944, in Nordheim, Germany. Her Mother, Margery (Vaughn) (Kasper) Kellar later married Robert L. Kellar.

Linda attended Rockford (IL) public schools and graduated from West High School with the Class of 1961. Linda was very active in High School: she worked on the “Warrior” (Yearbook); served as Home Room Secretary and Secretary of National Honor Society; and was a Member of ABL, Stagecrafters, Forum Club, Entre Nous, and Thespians Society. She was also a Baccalaureate Usher and Hostess at the Faculty Christmas Party. She worked on or appeared in the following theatrical productions: “You Can’t Take It

With You,” “Witness for the Prosecution,” and “Circus Daze.”

Linda and George Allen Leonardi exchanged marital vows in Chicago in October of 1970 and later moved to Germantown, TN where she died on February 9, 2011.
