Katie was on Cloud 9! The other event was meeting the newly elected United States. Senator Barack Obama at the Rockford Public Library. An Associated Press picture of Katie and the future President appeared in newspapers all over the country even seen by her Arizona godson.

That was Kate: she didn't want to be forgotten, and she won't be. She's a part of so many people in this world -touching so many like a thread in the quilt of life. This world is a better place because Katie was in it.

Katie worked for Rockford Public Schools, Head Start, Lenz Pharmacy, and Ingersoll Milling and Machine. She was a member of St. Anthony of Padua Catholic Church, Lithuanian Club Auxiliary, Montague House Mothers Club, YMCA, Edgewater Neighborhood Association, and the Wesley Willows band.
