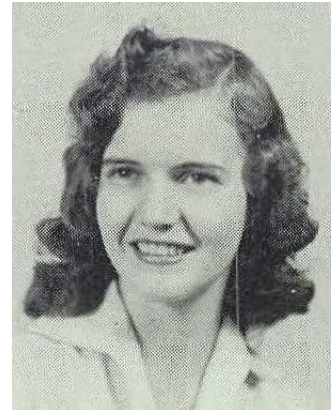
Alice attended Rockford Public Schools and graduated with Rockford's West High School Class of 1961.
