Wanda Antoinette Nowling, affectionately known as “Toni” and “Tone Tone” 79, of Rockford, IL passed away peacefully on Saturday

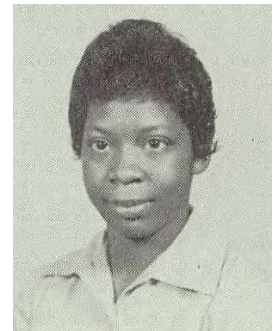
