

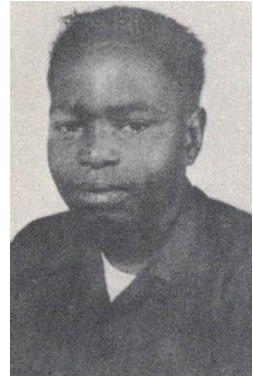
Jake Wilkins, Jr.

Jake Wilkins, Jr. was born in Rockford on July 31, 1943, to Jessie Mae and Jake Wilkins, Sr.



He attended Rockford public schools and was a member of the West High School Baseball Team. Jake enlisted in the **United States Air Force** and served his country for four years, from 1962 to 1966.



The eldest of ten siblings, Jake Wilkins, Jr. died at age 33 in San Mateo, CA. Jake was survived by his entire immediate family including: his now late (1998) Father and (2000) Mother; five Brothers including now late (1999) Joe Henry Wilkins, now late (2021) Jerry George Wilkins, now late (1999) James A. Wilkins, Jesse Wilkins (date of death unknown), and now late (1996) John Wilkins; and five Sisters including Janet Wilkins (Billy) Clark, Josephine Wilkins, now late (date of death unknown) Mary Wilkins, now late (2011) Rose Wilkins Simmons, and now late Justine Wilkins (date of death unknown).
