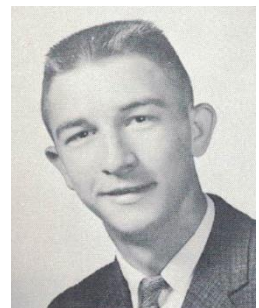
Joe married Sandra K. Frenk on April 16, 1966, at Trinity Lutheran Church in Harvard, IL.
