Dennis Williams Callahan, of White Lake, WI died Saturday, June 20, 2020, at the Hospice House in Wausau. He was 76 years old. He was born on August 11, 1943, in Brookfield, Wis. a son of William and Mary (Williams) Callahan. He married Mary Klimoski on February 12, 1972, at St. Stanislaus Catholic Church in White Lake. She preceded him in death on February 13, 2015.

A graduate of West High School, Rockford, IL, he school attended Eastern New Mexico University. In the 60's he was a member of Rockford's Phantom Regiment Drum and Bugle Corps in the 1960's. For many years Dennis was employed as a machine operator at White Lake's Yawkey Bissell Hardwood Flooring (later Robbins Inc.). He coached the White Lake High School football and basketball teams and the White Lake Little League.



In addition to his wife and parents he was predeceased by a sister-in-law, Patricia Lambert and brother-in-law, Joseph Klimoski.
