hester Lee Hudson was born May 31, 1943, in Decatur, IL to Bernice Hudson and R.V. Millough. Chester was educated in Rockford public schools and graduated from West High School with the Class of 1961. In High School Chester was a Band Member; in addition, he and a group of West High friends "brought down the house" when they sang Jerry Butler's "For Your Precious Love" in the School musical, "Circus Daze."

Chester served in the United States Air Force from 1961 to 1965. He and Wife Betty Hudson married and had a Son, the late Kelley Lamont Hudson who survived his Father but passed in 2022.

At age 50, Chester Lee Hudson died in Rockford on March 7, 1984. Ancestry records indicate Chester was predeceased by his Parents. As there was no obituary, we do not know if his Wife survived him. Son Kelley's obituary indicates both Parents (Chester Lee and Betty Hudson) predeceased him.
