Edward Alan Pierce of Riverton died at his home on West Sunset Thursday afternoon, July 31, 2008, at the age of 65. Edward Alan "Fast Eddie" Pierce was born in Orlando, FL, on July 15, 1943, the son of Malcolm Charles and Mary Ina (Fish) Pierce. The family moved to Rockford, IL in 1945 where he attended Summerdale Elementary School, Roosevelt Junior High School, and graduated from West High School in 1961.


He attended White Water State College in Whitewater, WI; in 1966, he earned a Bachelor of Science in Accounting, at the University of Colorado at Boulder.

Mr. Pierce, a United States Navy veteran stationed in LaMoore, CA; his last assignment was to the attack squadron 125 (YNSN). He was discharged from active-duty December 3, 1968 but remained on Reserve status until October 3, 1972. For his military duty he was awarded the National Defense Service Medal.

Ed was a Certified Public Accountant in Denver and Riverton. AMOCO employed him as a field Safety Engineer in Denver and Riverton and Evanston, WY. In 1996, he returned to Riverton to work for British Petroleum AMOCO and retired when AMOCO sold its interests in Fremont County, WY. For a few years after retiring, he worked as a consultant.

Mr. Pierce was a member of: B.P.O. Elks Lodge 3036 in Riverton, National Rifle association, a life member of the Citizens Committee for the Right to Keep and Bear Arms, Fremont County ATV Association, Riverton Country Club, Good Sam RV Club, and the Family Motor Coach Association

On March 8, 1999, he married NettaBell Girard at the United Presbyterian Church in Riverton with the Reverend Grayson Gowen officiating. Mr. Pierce is survived by his wife of Riverton and mother of Safford, AZ; sister, Janet L. (Steve) DeCori of Rockton, IL. He was predeceased by father, Malcolm C. Pierce; maternal grandparents, Harold W. and Ina May (Osterhous) Fish; and paternal grandparents, Malcolm and Nell Pierce.
