

Georgia Dawn Taylor Hiatt

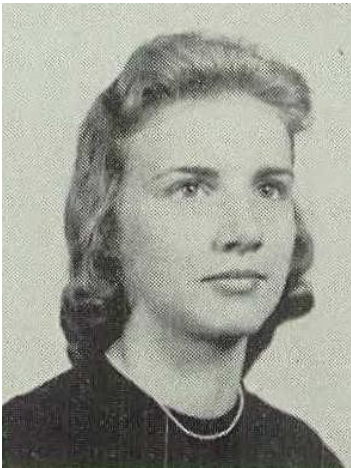
