and in various other jobs in the automotive industry; he likely he retired from his job as Inspector at J.I. Case.

Fred was predeceased by his Wife (December 3, 1988); Parents; Brother, Howard; and Sisters, Elsie and Edna. Survivors include Son, Richard C. (Geraldine) Sally (Rockford); Daughter, Lois Elizabeth Sally (New York); Grandsons, Jeffrey (Houston, TX) and Joel (Rockford); Brothers, Walter Sally (Colorado Springs, CO) and Irvin Sally (Phoenix, AZ); and many nieces and nephews.
