Lawrence Lloyd Alexander, 60, died in Order of Saint Francis (OSF) Saint Anthony Medical Center at 9:55 p.m. on Thursday, November 13, 2003. He was born in Rockford on Christmas Day, 1942, to Calvin K. and Bertha (Branch) Alexander.



Lawrence was a member of the graduating Class of 1961, West High School, where he played on the Football Team. After High School, he joined the United States Air Force, serving from 1961 to 1965. He worked for Ingersoll Milling Machine Company and was a faithful member of St. James Catholic Church.

Described as a man of few words with a roguish sense of humor, Larry married Christine Mary (Schopt) of Freeport. She survived him (2018) as did their Sons, Stephen (Amy) Alexander and Daniel Alexander. He will also be missed by Daughters, Elizabeth Alexander and Katherine (Ryan) Alexander Rawhoof. Larry's Sisters survived him: Armida Alexander, Betty Alexander (Talley) Weber, Constance K. Alexander, and Sandra Alexander Campbell. Surviving grandsons include Xzavier Rawhoof and Max, Ian, and Nathan Alexander. Larry also touched the lives of many nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends. He was predeceased by infant Brother, Jerry.
