Their three year-old son, Blaine, who had been left with a babysitter, was reared by Mary Ellen's mother, Lucille (Alex) Kelotis.

Mary Landstrom was employed by United Air Lines as was sister, Susan Brands, who confirmed the couple was indeed aboard the flight. Mary was predeceased by her father; in addition to her mother and sister, Mary was also survived by brothers John and Paul Brands, both of Rockford. Husband, Joel, was survived by his daughter from a previous marriage, Lisa Kay, 6; his mother, Mrs. Janelle Landstrom (Oak Park); his father, Edward (Rockford; his sisters, Cindy and Linda; and his Grandmother, Mrs. Oscar Landstrom, then residing in the Faust Hotel.
