

# Joseph Anthony Juliano

May 12, 2009 (Rockford, IL)

**A**fter a sudden illness, **Joseph Anthony Juliano**, 82, of Rockford died at 9:54 p.m. Tuesday, May 12, 2009, in Order of Saint Francis Saint Anthony Medical Center.

Born August 3, 1926, the son of Jerry and Rosalie Juliano, he lived his entire life in Rockford. He married Mary Anne (Triolo) Juliano on October 8, 1955. Joseph owned and operated Juliano Grocery Store for several years. He was a veteran of the United States Army, serving in World War (WW) II. He was a member of St. Anthony Church of Padua, the past-president of the Senior Holy Name Society, and an avid golfer.

“Juliano’s,” the grocery store, was a predecessor to 7-11’s, a niche between small corner grocery stores and yet-to-come supermarkets, and a fast-food lunch place because Washington Junior High School did not have a cafeteria. Now under new owners catering to a different ethnic community, the store still identified as “Juliano’s” or “the old Juliano’s” remains an historic landmark in the fabric of South Rockford – just like the corner stores run by the families of Classmates Joseph LaRosa and Frank Zammuto.

**Juliano “attended” schools in Rockford. Although he became a pillar of the South Rockford Community, a successful businessman, a proud patriotic member of the World War II “Greatest Generation,” a mentor, and a civic leader, he thought it important to fill a void in his resumé. At the age of many of our fathers he paused to earn his General Education Diploma (GED). We in the West High School Class of 1961 are honored that that achievement was recognized in the 1961 Commencement Program.**

Survivors include Wife, Mary Anne Juliano; Daughter, Lisa Marie Contini (Cadyville, NY); Son, Jerry Juliano (San Diego, CA); Grandchildren, Guiseppe E., Giovanna M. and Regina R. Contini; Sister, Rose Juliano (Rockford); Aunt, Vincenza Giuliano (Rockford); and many nieces, nephews and cousins.

A Memorial Service will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 23, in Saint. Anthony of Padua Church, with Visitation from 9:00 a.m. to time of Service; Franciscan Friars will officiate.
